Faculty-led Student Exchange Program at NCKU AISSM

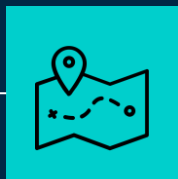

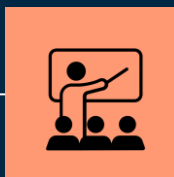

Tainan

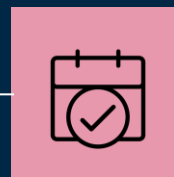

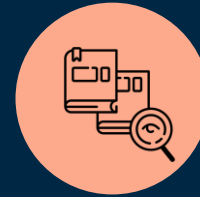

Cost of Study and Living Estimates

Tuition Fees

Under bilateral exchange agreements, nominated students pay tuition fees to their home university and are exempt from paying at NCKU. Students applying without nomination will pay NCKU's international student tuition fees. For details, please click the [tuition schedule](#).

Cost of Housing

Student dormitory: NT\$15,730 per semester (subject to change)

Off-campus: NT\$4100-\$8500 per month

Living Cost

Living expenses range from \$6,000 to \$10,000 NTD per month, depending on individual lifestyle.



Health Insurance & Exam



Health Insurance

Each student is required to join NCKU student group insurance at around NT\$260 for each semester upon registration.

Private overseas insurance

All exchange students need to purchase their own overseas medical and injury insurance, which includes health and accident coverage for the exchange period, in their home country before departure. Be aware to submit the copy when you register on campus.

Visa

*Please be advised not to enter the country with a landing visa (inextensible), whose 90 days period will not cover one semester.

Visitor visa for Foreign Students

Exchange students who will study for only one semester, must apply for a Taiwan (ROC) visitor visa with the annotation “FS” followed by the name of the host university, before entering Taiwan. [More information](#)

Resident Visa for Foreign Students

Exchange students, who will stay for two semesters and hold ordinary passports or other legal travel documents, may apply for a resident visa. After entering the ROC with a resident visa, please apply for an “Alien Resident Certificate” (ARC) within 30 days. [More information](#)
